



Con Corazón Outreach Report

11th January 2024 – Marampaqui

In this region, tree forests are scarce since the majority of vegetation around is straw and grass. The pine trees are located 300 meters from our Medical Center in Marampaqui. This small group of trees were planted more than 10 years ago as one of the projects carried out by Con Corazón. Since then, animals in the area such as alpacas and sheep can rest under the shade it produces. Also, the grass that grows around it, remains very fresh and more pleasant for the animals.

Another benefit that trees bring is that mushrooms grow under them. These are collected and then taken to a drying process under the sun. All this process happens in the homes of the collectors who are later in charge of selling them in the local market, producing a little economic income for their families.
