Many of our patients come from different villages around Marampaqui. Some of them have to walk about 2-3 hours in order to get a medical or dental treatment. Johni and her husband Dino, both are health promoters of our organization, begin their activities at 04:00 am because the patients are already arriving to our Medical center. They have to write down their names until we reach out the maximum of patients we can see in a day.

It is very nice to see what they do during the patient's waiting time. Some groups take advantage of this time to have meetings regarding their concerns within their community. Others are spinning alpaca wool to later weave sweaters, scarves and ponchos. During that time, we also approach them to have a little chat about their lives and experiences. It helps us to learn more about them and their concerns
